

Welcome to the Gaia Biological Park!

The Gaia Biological Park (Parque Biológico de Gaia – PBG) is an environmental education centre located on the outskirts of the city of Vila Nova de Gaia.

In addition to playing a key role in raising the population's awareness of the region's flora, fauna, climate and landscape, the Gaia Biological Park focuses significantly on educational initiatives aimed at children, by handing out educational materials and organising workshops and exhibitions.

It is also a natural park (with more than 170 animal species) whose designers sought to recreate natural habitats.
